PLANNING

The teacher will:

- Plan collaboratively for student learning.
- Use Toddle to plan units appropriately.
- Involve students in planning for their own learning and assessment.
- Plan engagements that build on students' previous knowledge and experience.
- Plan units of inquiry that accommodate a range of needs and abilities.
- Provoke inquiry through the provision of a stimulating environment and act as guide and facilitator.

TEACHING

The teacher will:

- Use a range of teaching strategies-small group, individual, whole class etc. Support and promote inquiry-based teaching and learning.
- Use a combination of teacher-input and independent student work during teaching.
- Build on what students already know.
- Empower students to feel responsible and show agency.
- Enable students to pursue real-life investigations through authentic tasks and experiences.

- Address the needs of students with different abilities.
- Create opportunities to celebrate student learning and share experiences with other students, parents and others within the learning community.
